FRESHMAN FOR A DAY PROGRAM

The **FRESHMAN FOR A DAY PROGRAM** is a great way for prospective students to experience The Prep for the first time. The Program is open to 8th graders between September 25 and February 2 and open to 7th graders from March 5 until May 18. To make an appointment to be a freshman for a day [ffad], please visit www.shp.org/ffad and register for an appointment with us.

Freshman For A Day visitors should arrive at **8:30am** if they visit on a Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday or a Friday OR at **9:20am** if visiting on a Thursday. In order to provide as personal a visit as possible, there is a limit of eight visitors per day. Classes typically begin at 8:45am on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays. On Thursdays, classes begin at 9:35am.

The visiting student can either bring his lunch or use the lunch voucher provided by the Admission Office upon arrival. Visitors may also bring money if they want to add to this voucher for extra lunch items. We will supply visitors with a pen and padfolio as well. Each visitor should dress in a dress shirt, tie and khaki-type pants with dress shoes (no sneakers). Visitors may also request specific hosts for the day when making their on-line appointment. Hosts must be freshmen. If visitors do not know any freshmen whom they would like to have serve as their hosts, the Admission Office will assign someone for them. Visitors should be picked up in the Admission Office at 2:50pm.
