



The *Knights of Setonia* shield is anchored by a blue cross: the cross representing our dedication to sacrifice and service; and blue, one of our school colors. In the center of the shield is the wyvern. The wyvern is taken directly from the Bayley family crest. The wyvern is a creature with a horned head, a scaly back, bat-like ears and wings, two legs ending in talons and a tail. As on the Seton family crest, the wyvern is a symbol for overthrowing the tyranny of a demonic enemy. As *Knights of Setonia*, the wyvern represents the Christian commitment to justice, the defense of human dignity, and service to the needy and marginalized. On the *Knights of Setonia* shield, the gold crown engraved with the words “Christus Rex,” proclaims that Jesus reigns as our sovereign King. The wyvern protects and defends the golden crown. At the top of the shield is the Latin phrase “Esto Vir,” which means “Be a Man.” A *Knight of Setonia* is a man of prayer, service and piety in the brotherhood of Christ.
